

Lovettsville Montessori School, Oasis Healthware take top prizes at small business plan awards

Lovettsville Montessori School, a planned preschool for children aged 3-6, and Oasis Healthware, a Dulles-based software company that electronically categorizes medical records, took the top awards at the Loudoun Small Business Development Center's second annual Business Plan Competition awards Nov. 16.

Lovettsville Montessori School, operated by Allison Frederick Harteis and Oasis Healthware, run by Thomas M. Walker, MD, won in the non-scalable and scalable model categories respectively.

Thirteen small businesses submitted their business plans for the competition, presenting in front of a panel of 11 judges on Nov. 16. Finalists in the non-scalable category included second runner-up, Wine N' Out, a wine bar to be located in Leesburg and run by Bill and Kristy Reynolds; and first runner-up, Market Alignment, a marketing company run by Aimee Taylor. Catoctin Creek Distilling Company in Purcellville came in second place in the scalable business model category.
